Our fire doorsets undergo independent testing in a UKAS approved test house, regularly exceeding test standards. Recent test evidence includes two separate successful bi-directional tests of flush FD30S door set combination frames with fanlight and sidelight and a bi-directional burns test of our doubleglazed range, which included our double-glazed doorset complete with double-glazed and panel sidelight.

Our test evidence gives us the scope to manufacture bespoke timber fire and security doorsets in a variety of bespoke sizes and styles.






